Background



North Central Michigan College

The Library of Things is a collection of items selected to promote personal exploration and discovery, well being, creativity, and self-growth. Launched in December 2021.



Jackson College

The Library of Things is designed to engage students by providing items that promote wellness, creativity, and discovery, as well as meet technological needs. Soft launch in April 2024; full launch September 2024.
















Lessons Learned & Lessons to Learn


