Book club overview

- In 2023, National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine published <u>Advancing Antiracism</u>, <u>Diversity</u>, <u>Equity</u>, <u>and Inclusion in STEMM</u> <u>Organizations</u>, a report detailing inequalities in STEMM representation, barriers to STEMM representation, and antiracist actions to take to move STEMM forward.
- In response to this report, Wayne State University Libraries created a book club alongside stakeholders on campus to discuss the findings.

What is an escape room, how did we build it, and why?

- Our escape room is a digital puzzle that prompts participants to answer questions in order to move through a museum and find lost pieces
- Our goal was to gamify the content to increase engagement and create a depressurized space for discussion
